Bucket of Love

Unique to WYA, the Bucket of Love program is an intergenerational program bringing together seniors/retirees with elementary students on a weekly basis. The mentors interact with the student at school and create crafts, play games and solve puzzles. Volunteers are any caring person who has an hour to spare on a weekly basis during the school year. Although support is provided, you do not need special training — just a desire to be a friend to a child!

Mentors Plus

Trained volunteers provide one-on-one companionship with a youth outside of school. Mentors Plus meet individually once a week and as a group once a month doing super cool events like the Sea Life Aquarium and The Henry Ford.

MOMS for moms

MOMS for moms is the avenue for moms seeking female companionship and an open forum to discuss motherhood. The best candidates are MOMs who empower others and moms who need a little boost/moral support. MOMS for moms meets monthly to *build* relationships and *strengthen* Waterford mothers. Snacks and activities are provided.

Waterford Youth Assistance is committed to help *strengthen* youth and families and to *prevent* and *reduce* juvenile delinquency, child neglect and child abuse by providing positive alternatives through volunteer involvement.
